#### SUMMARY AND ANALYSIS

The coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic in the EASF region is spreading more rapidly with countries reporting 2,495 more cases. So far, a total of 19,075 cases have been recorded which indicates a 13.2% increase in infections since the last report. EASF region makes up 9.6% of the 193,610 total continents infections.

The most affected countries in the EASF Region are Sudan with 6,081 total cases, Djibouti (4,278) and Kenya (2,872). The Republic of Seychelles has no case of corona virus infection.

The region has so far recorded 591 COVID-19 related deaths with Sudan reporting the highest number of deaths at 359, Kenya 85 and Somalia 84. This represents 3.1% mortality rate of the total reported cases. The mortality rate remains low within the Member States.


The trend of recoveries in the region continues to be very positive at 6,217 recoveries Sudan has recorded the highest at 2,014, Somalia (2,013) and Kenya (849). This represents 32.6% recovery rate of all total infected people.



#### Trend line 2: Category 2 - Countries with less than 1000 cases




#### **Global Trends**

The coronavirus COVID-19 is affecting 210 countries and territories around the world and 2 international conveyances. There global trends indicate that there are currently **7,149,266** confirmed cases, **3,490,745** recoveries and **407,511** deaths from the COVID-19 Pandemic.

The top five countries that have recorded the highest number of cases globally include the United States with 2,014,658 cases, Brazil (694,116), Russia (476,658), Spain (288,797) and UK (287,399). The highest recovery rate has been reported in USA with 763,303 cases, UK (302,084), Brazil (230,688), Italy (169,600) and France (166,584). The countries that have recorded the highest death rates are USA (112,665), UK (40,597), Brazil (37,312), Italy (33,964) and UK (29,209).


