Peace, Security and Stability, distinguish Chiefs, is the key to our economic prosperity and the development of our nations and well being of peoples.

Distinguished Guests, participants

Commendable strides have been made in the operationalization of the Eastern Africa Standby Force. We have at our disposal an instrument upon which we can build to further structural conflict prevention and sustain peace where it has been achieved. On the ground, the region through our individual Member States are showing greater pro-activeness in dealing with current conflict and crisis situations, with encouraging results. I call on all our member States , , to lend a helping hand to collectively push the
